## PUBLIC NOTICE PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING

The Borough of Saint-Laurent of the City of Montreal will hold a written consultation on the object and consequences of the first draft by-laws numbers **RCA08-08-0001-142** and **RCA08-08-0001-143**, modifying by-law number **RCA08-08-0001** on zoning, adopted on August 3, 2021.

Draft by-law number RCA08-08-0001-142 amending by-law number RCA08-08-0001 on zoning aims to:

• Authorize "menu" type electronic signs for catering establishments with drive-through services.

This provision is not subject to referendum approval and affects the entire territory of the Borough of Saint-Laurent.

**Draft by-law number RCA08-08-0001-143** amending by-law number RCA08-08-0001 on zoning aims to:

Authorize the specific use "2212-17 - Non-school special education" in zone B19-007.

These provisions are subject to referendum approval affecting the areas and affects the delimited B19-007 area:

- To the northwest by Chemin de la Côte-de-Liesse;
- To the southwest by the property line located at 6650-6652, chemin de la Côte-de-Liesse;
- To the south-east by the C.N. railway line as well as by the property line located at 8080, boulevard Cavendish:
- To the northeast by the property line located at 6400, chemin de la Côte-de-Liesse.

Under Ministerial Decree 2021-102 of February 5, 2021, any procedure, other than referendum, which is part of the decision-making process of a municipal body and which involves the movement or gathering of citizens is replaced by a written consultation of 'a period of 15 days, announced in advance by a public notice.

Thus, any person can send written comments, by email or by mail, for 15 days following the publication of the notice concerning the draft regulatory amendments, from **August 11 to August 25, 2021**, so that the council can assess their value before rendering a decision.
