Public notice is by the present given that at its regular sitting which will be held on October 4, 2021 at 7 p.m., the Borough council will render a decision about the minor exemption to the urban by-laws described hereafter. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the possibility for any interested person to be heard before the Council regarding this minor exemption request is replaced by a fifteen days written consultation, announced by a public notice, in accordance with the July 16, 2021 ministerial order n° 2021-054 taken by the minister of Québec Health and Social Services.

The exemption is to allow in P-5-317 zone, for a two-storey detached community building:

a ground floor height, in relation to the center of the street, of 2.38 m instead of the maximum required of 2.0 m;

a metal exterior cladding at a proportion of 100% instead of a maximum required proportion of 20%; a side setback, east of the lot, of 8.0 m instead of the required minimum of 12.9 m;

do not landscape a turfed strip of a width of 1 or 2 m, as required along the lot lines adjacent to a mineralized surface.
