By-law modifying by-law on the price determination of various goods, activities and municipal services for the fiscal year 2021 in order to remove for library subscribers the late fees for the loan of a document, a musical instrument or any other equipment and to adjust the codification regarding fees for the loss or damage of a document or any other equipment

BY-LAW MODIFYING BY-LAW CA29 0123 ON THE PRICE DETERMINATION OF VARIOUS GOODS, ACTIVITIES AND MUNICIPAL SERVICES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 IN ORDER TO REMOVE FOR LIBRARY SUBSCRIBERS THE LATE FEES FOR THE LOAN OF A DOCUMENT, A MUSICAL INSTRUMENT OR ANY OTHER EQUIPMENT AND TO ADJUST THE CODIFICATION REGARDING FEES FOR THE LOSS OR DAMAGE OF A DOCUMENT OR ANY OTHER EQUIPMENT

At the Borough of Pierrefonds-Roxboro regular sitting held by videoconference on September 13, 2021 at 7 p.m., in conformity with the Cities and Towns Act (L.R.Q., Chapter C-19), and in conformity with the ministerial orders by which the minister of Health and Social Services has implemented special measures for the municipalities in order to minimize the spreading risks associated with COVID-19, to which attend:

The Mayor of the Borough Mr. Dimitrios (Jim) Beis, Councillors Catherine Clément-Talbot, Yves Gignac, Benoit Langevin and Louise Leroux, all members of the Council and forming a quorum under the chairmanship of the Mayor of the Borough, Mr. Dimitrios (Jim) Beis.

The Director of the Borough, Mr. Dominique Jacob, and M<sup>e</sup> Alice Ferrandon, Secretary of the Borough, also attend by videoconference.

BY VIRTUE OF Section 145 of the Charter of Ville de Montréal (R.S.Q., Chapter C 11.4) authorizing the boroughs to adopt a by-law fixing a pricing to finance part of their goods, services, and activities;

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL ENACTS THE FOLLOWING:

By-law CA29 0123 on the price determination of various goods, activities and municipal services for the fiscal year 2021 is modified as follows:

ARTICLE 1 By the replacement of article 45 by as follows:

**45.** • For the loan, the reservation or the put-on layaway of a paper or audiovisual document, a musical instrument or equipment, no fees will be charged.

ARTICLE 2 By the replacement of article 46 by the following:

- 46.
- For any delay in returning to the library a borrowed document musical instrument or equipment, no fees will be charged.

ARTICLE 3 By the addition, at article 47, of points 11, 12, 13 and 14 as follows:

- 47. For any lost or damaged document or equipment, the following fees will be charged:
  11° minor damage of a musical instrument (non-essential elements or less expensive/minor repairs
  12° major damage of a musical instrument (essential elements or more expensive/important repair
  13° complete break of a musical instrument or case
  \$20 + \$5
  14° lost musical instrument
- ARTICLE 4 By the repeal of article 49.
- ARTICLE 5 By the repeal of article 50.
- ARTICLE 6 The present by-law comes into force on October 6, 2021.
