<u>APPLICATION FOR A MINOR EXEMPTION</u>

Notice is hereby given that the application for a minor exemption (article 145.6 of the *Act respecting land use planning and development*, CQLR, c. A-19.1) for the building at 4315 avenue de Courtrai will be submitted for a 15-day written consultation starting today, in accordance with ministerial order 2021-054.

This minor exemption would make it possible to authorize, for an existing building, a side wall located between 0.21 and 0.26 metres from the side lot line, notwithstanding article 71 of the *Urban planning by-law for Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce borough* (01-276), which stipulates that the side wall of a building that is not erected on the side lot line must be laid out at a distance equal to or greater than 1.5 metres.
