

ORDINANCES

Notice is given that the following ordinances were adopted at the executive committee meeting of November 25, 2021:

Ordonnance visant à établir et à modifier des voies de circulation à l'usage exclusif des autobus et de certaines autres catégories de véhicules (13)

Adopted under article 3 of the By-law concerning traffic and parking (R.B.C.M., c. C-4.1) to establish and modify reserved bus lanes and lanes for certain other vehicle categories, this ordinance modifies the types of users authorized in reserved lanes on Boulevard de la Côte-Vertu, between Boulevard Marcel-Laurin and Rue Bégin, in order to remove bikes.

Ordonnance adoptée dans le contexte de la pandémie de la COVID-19 – tarifs de stationnement sur rue (10)

Adopted under article 123 of the By-law concerning fees (fiscal 2021) (20-045) in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, this ordinance makes paid on-street parking in Ville-Marie borough free on Monday to Friday, from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m., as well as on Saturdays and Sundays, from December 3, 2021 to January 2, 2022.
