



## COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

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**Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of December 2, 2021:**

**RCG 17-011-2 Règlement modifiant le Règlement établissant le Programme d'aide à l'accessibilité des commerces (PAAC) (RCG 17-011)**

[By-law amending the By-law establishing the business accessibility assistance program (PAAC) (RCG 17-011)]

The purpose of the amendments is to enhance the program by including professional architect, engineer or technologist services in eligible costs and increasing the maximum subsidy amount to 90% of the cost of eligible work, up to a maximum of \$15,000.

[By-law amending the By-law concerning subsidies for the revitalization of commercial streets (Réussir@Montréal - commerce program) (RCG 15-082)]

**RCG 15-083-5 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur les subventions relatives à la revitalisation des secteurs commerciaux faisant l'objet de travaux majeurs d'infrastructure (Programme Réussir@Montréal - Artère en chantier) (RCG 15-083)**

[By-law amending the By-law concerning subsidies for the revitalization of commercial sectors undergoing major infrastructure work (Réussir@Montréal - arterial roads under construction program) (RCG 15-083)]

The purpose of the two above-mentioned by-laws is to extend the deadline for completing eligible work and amend the deadline for applicants to provide the documents required for the subsidy payment.
