Public notice is by the present given that at its regular sitting which will be held on January 17, 2022 at 7 p.m., the Borough council will render a decision about the minor exemption to the urban by-laws described hereafter. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the possibility for any interested person to be heard before the Council regarding this minor exemption request is replaced by a fifteen days written consultation, announced by a public notice, in accordance with the July 16, 2021 ministerial order n° 2021-054 taken by the minister of Québec Health and Social Services.

The exemption is to allow in C-3-223 zone, for a commercial building redevelopment project, that the existing and required berth be removed, an access aisle of 5.6 m instead of the required 6.5 m, and have 77 parking spaces instead of the required 80 parking spaces.
