Due to the state of emergency currently in effect and the special measures taken to limit the spread of the coronavirus, all city council meetings will be held behind closed doors until further notice. Therefore, council members will attend the meetings by teleconference.

As a result, the public will not be admitted to city hall during the next city council meeting. However, the meeting may be viewed via webcast (a live stream or recording).

The main purpose of the special meeting of **December 22, 2021**, will to table the city's ten-year capital works program for 2022-2031 (central city component), the 2022 budget (central city component) and to table the 2022 budgets of certain paramunicipal agencies.

Residents can also ask elected officials questions by sending them in writing **before 10 a.m., on Wednesday, December 22, 2021**, according to the special instructions posted on the page of the December 22, 2021 special city council meeting on the city's website at **montreal.ca**.

The special instructions will replace the regular public oral question period.
