Notice is given that a special urban agglomeration council meeting will be held as follows:

Due to the state of emergency currently in effect and the special measures taken to limit the spread of the coronavirus, all urban agglomeration council meetings will be held behind closed doors until further notice. Therefore, council members will attend the meetings by teleconference.

As a result, the public will not be admitted to city hall during the next urban agglomeration council meeting. However, the meeting may be viewed via webcast (a live stream or recording).

The main purpose of the special meeting of **December 22, 2021**, will be to table the city's ten-year capital works program (urban agglomeration component) for 2022-2031, the 2022 budget (urban agglomeration component), the capital works program for 2022-2031 of the Société de transport de Montréal and to table the 2022 budgets of certain paramunicipal agencies.

Residents can also ask elected officials questions by sending them in writing **before 2:30 p.m., on Wednesday, December 22, 2021**, according to the special instructions posted on the page of the December 22, 2021 special urban agglomeration council meeting on the city's website at montreal.ca.

The special instructions will replace the regular public oral question period.
