



COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of January 27, 2022:

RCG 06-054-10 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur les dépenses mixtes (RCG 06-054)

[By-law amending the By-law concerning mixed expenditures (RCG 06-054)]

The object of the by-law is to update support units and adjust the distribution of mixed administrative expenditures.

RCG 22-003 Règlement sur les tarifs de l'agglomération de Montréal (exercice financier 2022)

[By-law concerning fees of the urban agglomeration of Montréal (fiscal 2022)]

RCG 22-005 Règlement modifiant le Règlement 72 relatif à l'établissement et à la dénomination de parcs à caractère régional afin d'agrandir le territoire du parc-nature du Bois-de-Liesse

[By-law amending By-law 72 respecting the establishment and designation of regional parks to expand the territory of the Bois-de-Liesse nature park]

The purpose of the amendments is to add lots 1 901 434 and 1 901 435, cadastre of Québec, to the boundaries of the Bois-de-Liesse nature park.

RCG 19-010-1 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur les subventions relatives au Programme investissements durables, volet bâtiments industriels durables (RCG 19-010)

[By-law amending the By-law concerning subsidies under the sustainable investments program, sustainable industrial buildings component (RCG 19-010)]

The object of the by-law is to amend the interpretation of "industrial activity", to add urban farming as an economic sector covered by the program.

These by-laws come into force January 31, 2022, and may be consulted during regular business hours at the Service du greffe, 155, rue Notre-Dame Est. They are also available at montreal.ca./reglements-municipaux.
