



**PUBLIC NOTICE
COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS**

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of November 29, 2021:

21-046 Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 113 437 000 \$ afin de financer les travaux de protection et de transition écologique dans les immeubles municipaux

[By-law authorizing a loan of \$113,437,000 for protection and ecological transition work in municipal immovables]

21-048 Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 23 484 000 \$ pour le financement des coûts afférents à la réalisation d'une partie de l'Entente sur le développement culturel de Montréal 2021-2024 et des coûts afférents à la réalisation des parties reportées des Ententes sur le développement culturel de Montréal conclues pour des années antérieures à 2021

[By-law authorizing a loan of \$23,484,000 for costs related to the completion of part of the 2021-2024 agreement on Montréal's cultural development and the costs related to the completion of parts of the city's cultural development agreements carried over from the years prior to 2021]

08-037-1 Règlement modifiant le Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 12 000 000 \$ afin de financer l'acquisition du lot 3 731 871, ainsi que la réalisation d'un lien routier entre le chemin Saint-François et le boulevard de la Côte-Vertu, pour la desserte des projets industriels implantés sur le territoire de l'aéroport international Pierre-Elliott-Trudeau (08-037)

[By-law amending the By-law authorizing a loan of \$12,000,000 for the acquisition of lot 3 731 871, and the development of a link between Chemin Saint-François and Boulevard de la Côte-Vertu, serving industrial projects on the territory of the Pierre-Elliott Trudeau International Airport (08-037)]

The purpose of the amendments is to reduce the loan amount to \$9,017,711, delete any reference to the acquisition of lot 3 731 831 that is not financed under this by-law as well as add a sector to the tax sector.

The Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing approved all these by-laws on January 19, 2022. They come into force on January 31, 2022 and may be consulted during regular office hours at the Service du greffe, 155 rue Notre-Dame Est. They are also available at montreal.ca./reglements-municipaux.
