Petition presented under schedule B to the *By-Law concerning the Montréal Charter of Rights and Responsibilities and the Right of Initiative (05-056)*

INSTALLATION OF A TREKFIT OUTDOOR FITNESS EQUIPMENT IN J.-ALBERT-GARIÉPY PARK IN VERDUN

Beginning of the petition signing period (90 days)

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given:

A draft petition in order to obtain a public consultation for the *installation of a trekfit outdoor fitness equipment in J.-Albert-Gariépy Park, in Verdun* was filed at the Secretary of the Borough's office on November 22, 2021 under the right of initiative provided for in *the By-Law concerning the Montréal Charter of Rights and Responsibilities and the Right of Initiative (05-056)* (05-056), (hereinafter the "By-Law").

This draft petition having been deemed eligible, confirmation of its eligibility was sent on November 26, 2021 to the person in charge of the petition. A copy of this reply was further filed at the regular council meeting of Verdun held on December 7, 2021.

Beginning and duration of the petition signing period

In accordance with article 10 of schedule B to the By-Law, the signing period is of 90 days and it begins on the day of the publication of this notice and **ends on April 20, 2022**.

Number of signatures required

The number of signatures required for the conformity of the petition must be **2975**.

Persons able to sign the petition

An individual aged 15 or more, residing on the territory of Verdun is a person qualified to sign the petition.

Conditions to sign the petition

The standard petition form provided by the city must be used to exercise the right of initiative. No other petition form is receivable.

The form referred to in the first paragraph must be completed and transmitted in accordance with specifications.

Every person who signs a petition to exercise the right of initiative must, at the place and in the manner provided for, solemnly *déclarer* that he meets the criteria as a person qualified to sign.

Electronic signatures are accepted on the city's standard petition form in electronic format for the exercise of the right of initiative.
