## WRITTEN CONSULTATION MINOR EXEMPTION N<sup>0</sup> 3003053336

Public notice is by the present given that at its regular sitting which will be held on March 7, 2022 at 7 p.m., the Borough council will render a decision about the minor exemption to the urban by-laws described hereafter. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the possibility for any interested person to be heard before the Council regarding this minor exemption request is replaced by a fifteen days written consultation, announced by a public notice, in accordance with the July 16, 2021 ministerial order n° 2021-054 taken by the minister of Québec Health and Social Services.

The exemption is to allow, in C-3-216 zone, for a detached commercial building:

- a number of parking spaces of 9 parking spaces instead of the required minimum of 10 spaces;
- a minimum circulation aisle width of 5.72 m instead of the required minimum of 6.50 m;
- an exemption from the requirement to provide a minimum of 1 m from any lot line for off-street parking;
- an exemption from the obligation to provide a parking space bordered by a 1 m grass strip;
- an existing flat sign extending beyond the top of the building to which it is attached.
