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## **By-law for a Diverse Metropolis**

At its meeting on February 21, 2022, city council adopted a draft by-law titled “By-law amending the By-law to improve the supply of social, affordable and family housing (20-041)”.

This draft by-law replaces schedule B of the By-law to improve the supply of social, affordable and family housing (20-041) with the objective of adding one affordable housing zone in the borough of Plateau-Mont-Royal.

In compliance with the rules adopted under the COVID-19 state of emergency, the city will hold a 15-day public consultation aimed at collecting questions and comments in writing from residents concerning this draft by-law. The written consultation replaces the public meeting required under the Act respecting land use planning and development.
