Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of February 21, 2022:

19-022-4 **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le programme de subventions relatif à la réhabilitation des terrains contaminés (19-022) afin de le rendre conforme à l'avenant no 4 à l'Entente intervenue entre la Ville de Montréal et la ministre du Développement durable, de l'Environnement et de la Lutte contre les changements climatiques pour la réhabilitation de terrains contaminés situés sur le territoire de la Ville de Montréal**

[By-law amending the By-law concerning the subsidy program for the rehabilitation of contaminated land (19-022) to bring it into compliance with addendum No.4 to the agreement between the city and the Minister of Sustainable Development, the Environment and the Fight Against Climate Change, for the rehabilitation of contaminated land located on city territory]

22-011 **Règlement de contrôle intérimaire limitant les hauteurs et les densités dans l'arrondissement de Ville-Marie**

[Interim control by-law limiting heights and densities in Ville-Marie borough]
This by-law is adopted as part of the adoption process of draft by-law P-04-047-235 which will amend the city's planning program concerning the sector of Chinatown.
