COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of February 24, 2022:

RCG 20-005-2 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le programme de subventions relatif à la réhabilitation de terrains contaminés dans l'Est de Montréal (RCG 20-005)

[By-law amending the By-law concerning the subsidy program for the rehabilitation of contaminated land in the East End of Montréal (RCG 20-005)]

The purpose of the amendments is specifically to increase the subsidy rates.

RCG 21-003-2 Règlement modifiant le Règlement intérieur du conseil d'agglomération sur la délégation de pouvoirs du conseil d'agglomération au comité exécutif dans le cadre de l'Initiative pour la création rapide de logements (ICRL) (RCG 21-003)

[By-law amending the Urban agglomeration council internal management by-law concerning the delegation of urban agglomeration council powers to the executive committee for purposes of the Rapid Housing Initiative (RHI) (RCG 21-003)]

The by-law amends article 1 to expand the powers delegated to the executive committee.
