

**PUBLIC NOTICE
PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING**

The Borough of Saint-Laurent of the City of Montreal will hold a written consultation on the purpose and consequences of draft by-law number **RCA08-08-0001-148**, amending by-law number **RCA08-08-0001 on zoning**, adopted on March 1, 2022.

Draft by-law number RCA08-08-0001-148 amending by-law number RCA08-08-0001 on zoning aims to:

- frame the installation on a sloping roof of solar shingles, solar thermal and photovoltaic panels
- set the objectives and criteria applicable to a project to install solar shingles and solar thermal and photovoltaic panels on a sloping roof

This regulation is not subject to referendum approval.

Some of these provisions are subject to referendum approval and may affect the entire territory.

Under Ministerial Decree 2021-054 of July 16, 2021, any procedure, other than referendum, which is part of the decision-making process of a municipal body and which involves the movement or gathering of citizens is replaced by a written consultation of a period of 15 days, announced in advance by a public notice.

Thus, any person can send written comments, by email or by mail, for 15 days from **March 16 to 30, 2022** inclusive, so that the Board can assess their value before rendering a decision. For any questions regarding this procedure, please call 514 855-6000 extension 4093.
