

PUBLIC NOTICE

Cavendish extension project in the urban agglomeration of Montréal

This notice is published to inform the public of the commencement of the project's environmental assessment.

The Cavendish extension project is an urban mobility project whose scale and benefits far exceed the connection of two existing road segments. In addition to connecting Boulevard Cavendish itself, the project involves connecting boroughs through Avenue Royalmount and providing a new eastward connection toward the future Namur-Hippodrome ecodevelopment, while giving a prominent place to public transit, active transportation and green spaces.

For more information, the public may consult the project notice filed by its proponent with the Minister of Sustainable Development, the Environment and the Fight Against Climate Change, which includes, in particular, a description of the project and the site concerned, as well as a description of the main issues identified and impact anticipated on the receiving environment.

The project notice and the Minister's directive respecting the carrying out of the project's environmental impact assessment statement are available for consultation in the public register of the projects subject to the environmental impact assessment and review procedure, at the following Internet address: <https://www.ree.environnement.gouv.qc.ca/index.asp>.

Any person, group or municipality may submit to the Minister, in writing and not later than **April 15, 2022**, observations on the issues that the project's environmental impact assessment statement should address. Those observations may be sent to the Minister through the public register at the above-mentioned Internet address.
