



PUBLIC NOTICE IS GIVEN AS FOLLOWS

In compliance with *Demolition by-law LAS-0145*, the borough of LaSalle Demolition Committee will hold a virtual meeting April 6, 2022 at 7 p.m. to render a decision regarding the demolition authorization request for the immovable located at 1791-1819 avenue Dollard. The proposed reutilization program for the vacated land pertains to the construction of a five-storey building consisting of 166 dwellings and a commercial ground floor. The deferred broadcast will be available on the borough's website at montreal.ca/lasalle under the tile *All about virtual consultations, registers and demolitions in LaSalle*.

Considering the current health emergency and in conformity with the ministerial decrees regarding processes other than referendums which are part of a municipal organization's decision making process and which require the travel or gathering of citizens, anyone can submit their comments in writing, for a period of 15 days following the publication of this notice.

Any person wishing to express their opposition to this demolition must, within fifteen days from the publication of this public notice or within fifteen days following the posting of the public notice on the concerned immovable, submit their written opposition to the LaSalle borough secretary by one of the following means :

Oppositions must be received no later than April 2, 2022. People submitting applications by mail are invited to do so rapidly considering postal delivery delays.

Irrespective of the means of communication used, all individuals submitting an opposition must specify their name and address as well as a phone number or e-mail address where they can be easily reached.

Oppositions received will be read during the virtual meeting to be held at the aforementioned date and time.
