



COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of March 24, 2022:

- RCG 22-009** **Règlement autorisant la démolition du bâtiment situé au 4295, rue De Richelieu et son remplacement par la construction du poste de ventilation mécanique Richelieu**
[By-law authorizing the demolition of a building located at 4295, rue De Richelieu and its replacement with the construction of the Richelieu mechanical ventilation station]
- RCG 12-003-4** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le Service de sécurité incendie de Montréal (RCG 12-003)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning the Service de sécurité incendie de Montréal (RCG 12-003)]
The amendments apply to articles 32 and 33.1, and impose new requirements in order to comply with the federal environmental emergency regulations.
- RCG 12-026-4** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le Code de conduite des employés de la Ville de Montréal (RCG 12-026)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning the Code of conduct of Ville de Montréal employees (RCG 12-026)]
Specifically, the purpose of the amendments is to state that no municipal employee may accept any benefit from a supplier of goods and services as well as to change the title of the code.

These by-laws come into force March 30, 2022, and may be consulted during regular business hours at the Service du greffe, 155, rue Notre-Dame Est. They are also available at montreal.ca/reglements-municipaux/.
