



COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of April 28, 2022:

RCG 22-003-1 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur les tarifs de l'agglomération de Montréal (exercice financier 2022) (RCG 22-003)

[By-law amending the By-law concerning fees of the urban agglomeration of Montréal (fiscal 2022) (RCG 22-003)]

The purpose of the amendments is to extend the validity period of the Espace pour la vie Passport and to create a special rate fee schedule for residents of the Communauté métropolitaine de Montréal.

RCG 09-029-1 Règlement modifiant le Règlement relatif à la fréquentation et à la conservation des parcs régionaux de la Ville de Montréal (RCG 09-029)

[By-law amending the By-law concerning the use and preservation of regional parks of Montréal (RCG 09-029)]

The purpose of the amendments is to update the by-law, specifically as to protection of fauna and flora and park opening hours. In addition, by-law 05-059 is repealed with respect to parks under urban agglomeration council jurisdiction.

RCG 10-016-2 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur les parcs relevant de la compétence du conseil d'agglomération de Montréal (RCG 10-016)

[By-law amending the By-law concerning parks under the authority of the urban agglomeration council of Montréal (RCG 10-016)]

The purpose of the amendments is to update the by-law, specifically by adding a chapter concerning protection of the environment and a list of parks covered under the by-law.

RCG 20-013-2 Règlement modifiant le Règlement intérieur du conseil d'agglomération sur la délégation de pouvoirs du conseil d'agglomération au comité exécutif relatif à l'exercice du droit de préemption aux fins de logement social (RCG 20-013)

[By-law amending the Urban agglomeration council internal management by-law concerning the delegation of urban agglomeration council powers to the executive committee regarding the exercise of the city's pre-emptive right for social housing purposes (RCG 20-013)]

The amendment takes into account the additional lots subject to the city's pre-emptive under resolution CG22 0198.
