The meeting will be streamed on the borough website.

In view of the public health measures in effect in Quebec to limit the risk of spreading the COVID-19 virus, and so as to maintain physical distancing of one metre, no more than 34 residents may be present in the room. We cannot allow any more residents than this to attend the meeting in person.

At the meeting, there will be a 90-minute period reserved for <u>oral and written</u> questions on any issue concerning your borough or the municipal administration. The period for oral questions, for those present in the Borough Council room, will be 45 minutes. The period for written questions submitted online using the electronic form will also be 45 minutes.

People at the meeting who have registered for the oral question period will be allowed to speak first. There will be a registration period from 6:15 to 6:45 p.m. for this purpose.

The period for written questions will begin once the time limit for oral questions has expired or if there are no further people who have registered at the meeting. If you wish to submit a question in writing, you may use the <u>form</u> available online on the <u>Côte-des-Neiges-Notre-Dame-de-Grâce website</u>, in the *Borough Council* section (<u>montreal.ca/cote-des-neiges-notre-dame-de-grace</u>), up until noon on Monday, May 2, 2022. After this date, messages will not be read and questions submitted will not be eligible.

People attending the meeting must wear a mask at all times and remain one metre apart from other people in the room.
