Notice is given that the following ordinances were adopted at the executive committee meeting of June 1, 2022:

Ordonnance désignant le projet d'aménagement de la rue Sainte-Catherine Ouest et établissant la nature des travaux réalisés sur le domaine privé et la répartition des coûts (1)

Ordonnance désignant le projet d'aménagement de la rue Peel et établissant la nature des travaux réalisés sur le domaine privé et la répartition des coûts (2)

These ordinances, adopted under article 3 of the By-law establishing the beautification program for private property as part of public property development projects (22-020), designate the Rue Sainte-Catherine Ouest and Rue Peel development projects and establish the nature of the work carried out on private property as well as the allocation of the costs. The ordinances make their respective territories subject to the by-law.

Ordonnance modifiant l'Ordonnance relative à la collecte des matières résiduelles pour le territoire de l'arrondissement de Villeray–Saint-Michel–Parc-Extension (numéro 19) (19-4)

This ordinance, adopted under article 18 of the By-law concerning collection services (16-049), amends the ordinance related to the collection of residual materials for the territory of Villeray–Saint-Michel–Parc-Extension borough. The amendments concern the use of containers for the purposes of the collection of recyclable materials as well as the schedules for the collection of green and food waste.
