

**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING**

The Borough of Saint-Laurent of the City of Montreal will hold a public consultation meeting regarding the purpose and consequences of draft by-laws number **RCA08-08-0001-150** and **RCA08-08-0001-152** and the first draft by-law, **RCA08-08-0001-151** modifying by-law number RCA08-08-0001 on zoning, adopted on June 7, 2022. This meeting will take place on **June 21, 2022, at 7 p.m.**, in the council room of the town hall of borough located at 777, boulevard Marcel-Laurin, Saint-Laurent.

Draft by-law number **RCA08-08-0001-150** aims to:

- Amend the zoning by-law to authorize a billboard in zone C10-006.

This provision is not subject to referendum approval.

Draft by-law number **RCA08-08-0001-151** aims to:

- Modify the zoning by-law to reduce the parking ratio for the project of 4 multi-family dwellings located at the southeast intersection of Cavendish and Thimens boulevards.

This provision is subject to referendum approval and affects zone H12-043 approximately delimited by the perimeter formed to the north by boulevard Thimens, to the east by lot PC-01772 and rue Modugno, to the south by Bourbonnière park and west by Cavendish Boulevard.

A request can come from zone H12-043 and all zones adjacent to it.

Draft by-law number **RCA08-08-0001-152** aims to:

- Amend the zoning by-law to modify the standards relating to signage in zone I14-012.

This provision is not subject to referendum approval. During this public meeting, the borough mayor (or another designated member of the Borough Council) will explain the draft by-law as well as the consequences of its adoption and will hear from people who wish to speak about it.

These draft by-laws are available for consultation at the Citizens' Office, during regular office hours.
