

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of March 21, 2022:

- 22-012** **Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 10 158 000 \$ pour des travaux reliés à l'enlèvement des fils et des poteaux et à la conversion du réseau aérien au réseau municipal de conduits souterrains sous la surveillance de la Commission des services électriques de Montréal**
[By-law authorizing a loan of \$10,158,000 for work related to the removal of wires and poles and the conversion of the overhead network to the municipal network of underground conduits, under the supervision of the Commission des services électriques de Montréal]
- 22-013** **Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 10 000 000 \$ afin de financer le programme de soutien aux arrondissements pour l'aménagement et la réfection des jardins communautaires et collectifs publics**
[By-law authorizing a loan of \$10,000,000 for the borough support program for the development and restoration of public community gardens]
- 20-051-1** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 47 700 000 \$ afin de financer les travaux d'infrastructures et d'aménagement de la place des Montréalaises ainsi que les travaux de réaménagement du domaine public aux abords du métro Champ-de-Mars (20-051) afin d'augmenter le montant de l'emprunt à 55 200 000 \$**
[By-law amending the By-law authorizing a loan of \$47,700,000 for infrastructure and development work at Place des Montréalaises, as well as redevelopment work on public property around the Champ-de-Mars metro station (20-051) to increase the loan amount to \$55,200,000]

The Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing approved by-law 20-051-1 on June 13, 2022, and approved by-laws 22-012 and 22-013 on June 14, 2022. All these by-laws come into force on June 22, 2022 and may be consulted during regular office hours at the Service du greffe, 155 rue Notre-Dame Est.
