PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING

The Borough of Saint-Laurent of the City of Montreal will hold a public consultation meeting regarding the purpose and consequences of the first draft by-law number **RCA08-08-0001-153** amending by-law number **RCA08-08-0001** on the zoning, adopted on June 28, 2022. This meeting will be held on **August 2, 2022, at 7 p.m.**, in the council room of the borough hall located at 777, boulevard Marcel-Laurin, Saint-Laurent.

First draft by-law number RCA08-08-0001-153 aims to:


- Amend the urban planning by-law in order to modify the limit of zone I04-012 in order to include the new lot created for the needs of a construction project.

This provision is subject to referendum approval and affects all zones I04-010, I04-011, I04-012, I04-017, S04-006, I04-003, I04-001, P04-013, P04-019, I04-014, I04-017, I05-019 and I04-008 (see attached zone map).

During this public meeting, the borough mayor (or another designated member of the Borough Council) will explain the draft by-law as well as the consequences of its adoption and will hear from people who wish to speak about it.

The draft by-law is available for consultation at the Citizens' Office, during regular office hours.
