

**COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS** 

Notice is given that the following by-law was adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of March 24, 2022:

RCG 22-010Règlement de contrôle intérimaire relatif à la préservation d'un secteur<br/>présentant une valeur environnementale<br/>[Interim control by-law concerning the preservation of a sector that has<br/>environmental value]<br/>The by-law specifies the only uses allowed in the area of the borough of<br/>Anjou shown in schedule A to the by-law.

The Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing notified an opinion, June 23, 2022 with regard to by-law 22-010, stating that by-law is consistent with government policy directions regarding land use development. Consequently, by-law RCG 22-010 comes into force on June 23, 2022, in accordance with section 66 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1).
