

PUBLIC NOTICE
TO THE INTERESTED PERSONS ENTITLED TO
SIGN AN APPLICATION FOR AN APPROVAL BY WAY OF REFERENDUM

Following the public consultation meeting held on August 2, 2022, the Council of the Borough of Saint-Laurent adopted, at the general meeting of August 9, 2022, the second draft by-law number **RCA08-08-0001-153** modifying by-law RCA08-08-0001 on zoning.

This said second draft by-law contains provisions which may cause interested persons to request that the by-law containing such provisions be submitted to their approval in conformity with the Act Respecting Elections and Referendums in Municipalities.

The object of second draft by-law number RCA08-08-0001-153 is to:

- Amend the urban planning by-law in order to modify the limit of zone I04-012 in order to include the new lot created for the needs of a construction project.

This provision is subject to referendum approval and affects all zones I04-010, I04-011, I04-012, I04-017, S04-006, I04-003, I04-001, P04-013, P04-019, I04-014, I04-017, I05-019 and I04-008 (see attached zone map).

An application, in order to be valid, must:

- state clearly the provision to which it refers and the zone from which it originates;
- be received at the Bureau of the Secretary of the Borough of Saint-Laurent within eight days of the present notice, i.e., from August 11 to August 18, 2022;
- be signed by at least 12 interested persons in a zone in which there are more than 21 interested persons, or, in other cases, by a majority of the interested persons.

The information allowing to determine the interested persons having the right to sign an application may be obtained at the Bureau of the Secretary of the Borough of Saint-Laurent, during the regular office hours.

Where no valid application is received in respect to the second draft by-laws, the provisions may be included in a by-law that is not required to be submitted for the approval of the qualified voters.

This second draft by-law may be consulted at the Borough of Saint-Laurent, at 777, Marcel-Laurin Boulevard, Saint-Laurent, H4M 2M7, during the regular office hours.
