

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given, according to the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-law was adopted by the urban agglomeration council at its meeting of June 16, 2022:

RCG 22-023 By-law authorizing the construction and occupancy of a building on lot 6 333 058, cadastre of Québec, for housing purposes for persons in need of help and assistance

The by-law provides for a new use for the site of the former Sainte-Émélie convent. It includes departures from the urban planning by-law for Mercier–Hochelaga-Maisonneuve borough (01-275). (CG22 0433)

Following the public notice published on June 16, 2022, in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), by-law RCG 22-023 is deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of July 22, 2022, and comes into force on that date.
