ORDINANCES

Notice is given that the following ordinances were adopted at the executive committee meeting of August 3, 2022:

Ordonnance relative aux documents intitulés « Fiche bâtiment / Déclaration de conformité » (4)

This ordinance, adopted under article 35 of the By-law concerning the construction and conversion of buildings (11-018), replaces the documents titled “Fiche bâtiment / Déclaration de conformité” (building specification / statement of compliance form) referred to in article 1 of ordinance 3.

Ordonnance modifiant les loyers abordables prévus à l’annexe A (2)

This ordinance, adopted under article 35 of the By-law concerning the support program for the renovations of multi-rental buildings (20-005), amends the affordable rents in tables 1 and 2 of schedule A to the by-law. In particular, the ordinance amends the rent ceilings used to establish eligibility and the increase for a subsidy under the Affordable Housing Renovation Program.

Ordonnance – accès gratuit au Jardin botanique, au Biodôme, au Planétarium Rio Tinto Alcan et à l’Insectarium pour les membres de Canoo (7)

This ordinance, adopted under article 136 of the By-law concerning fees (fiscal 2022) (22-004), grants free admission to the abovementioned establishments for members of Canoo, accompanied by a maximum of 4 children aged 5 to 17.

Ordonnance – accès gratuit à la Biosphère pour les membres de Canoo (3)

This ordinance, adopted under article 93 of the By-law concerning fees of the urban agglomeration of Montréal (fiscal 2022) (RCG 22-003), grants free admission to the Biosphere for members of Canoo, accompanied by a maximum of 4 children aged 5 to 17.

All these ordinances come into force on August 9, 2022, and are available for consultation during regular office hours at the Service du greffe, 155, rue Notre-Dame Est, as well as online at montreal.ca/reglements-municipaux/.
