



COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of September 19, 2022:

- 22-038 Règlement sur la fermeture d'une ruelle située au sud-est du boulevard Henri-Bourassa Est, entre la 40^e et la 41^e Avenue, dans l'arrondissement de Rivière-des-Prairies–Pointe-aux-Trembles, aux fins de transfert aux propriétaires riverains**
[By-law to close a lane located southeast of Boulevard Henri-Bourassa Est, between 40^e Avenue and 41^e Avenue, in Rivière-des-Prairies–Pointe-aux-Trembles borough, for the purposes of transfer to bordering owners]
- 19-022-5 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le programme de subventions relativ à la réhabilitation des terrains contaminés (19-022)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning the subsidy program for the rehabilitation of contaminated land (19-022)]
The purpose of the by-law is specifically to include social housing projects funded by the Société d'habitation du Québec in the program, clarify the contract awarding process for the performance of work and increase the maximum subsidy unit costs.
- 02-003-8 Règlement modifiant le Règlement identifiant les réseaux de voirie artérielle et locale (02-003)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning the arterial and local road systems (02-003)]
The by-law replaces schedule 1 “Administrative arterial system, Ville de Montréal, 2021” to take into account changes made to the road system since the last amendment.
- 22-043 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur la subvention à la modification du raccordement du service électrique de certains bâtiments (R.R.V.M., chapitre S-6.01)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning subsidies for the alteration of the electrical service connection of certain buildings (R.B.C.M., chapter S-6.01)]
The by-law adds the sector of Rue Édouard and Rue Alepin and 4^e Avenue and 8^e Avenue, in LaSalle borough, and sets out the maximum subsidy applicable to the addresses in that sector.
- 22-044 Règlement sur le Comité consultatif en reconnaissance**
[By-law concerning the Comité consultatif en reconnaissance]

02-136-11 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le Conseil du patrimoine de Montréal (02-136)

[By-law amending the By-law concerning the Conseil du patrimoine de Montréal (02-136)]

The purpose of the amendments is to withdraw the function related to projects to identify an intangible heritage element as well as historic persons, events and sites which is now under the responsibility of the Comité consultatif en reconnaissance. Amendments are also made to the procedures of the Conseil du patrimoine and the rules for producing a statement of heritage interest.

20-041-5 Règlement modifiant le Règlement visant à améliorer l'offre en matière de logement social, abordable et familial (20-041)

[By-law amending the By-law to improve the supply of social, affordable and family housing (20-041)]

The purpose of the by-law is to replace schedule B in order to add an affordable housing area on the territory of Rivière-des-Prairies-Pointe-aux-Trembles borough.

16-082-1 Règlement modifiant le règlement 16-082

[By-law to amend by-law 16-082]

The amendments reduce to 12 m (4 storeys) the maximum height of tower 6 in the plans shown in schedule B to the By-law authorizing the construction of a building complex on the site bounded by Boulevard René-Lévesque, Avenue Atwater, Rue Tupper and Rue du Sussex (16-082)".

All these by-laws come into force September 26, 2022, and may be consulted during regular business hours at the Service du greffe, 155, rue Notre-Dame Est. They are also available at montreal.ca/reglements-municipaux/.
