



COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that:

- urban agglomeration council adopted the following by-laws at its meeting of August 25, 2022:

RCG 22-027 Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 2 019 000 \$ afin de financer les interventions municipales afférentes à la déconstruction du pont Champlain

[By-law authorizing a loan of \$2,019,000 for municipal operations related to the deconstruction of the Champlain Bridge]

RCG 22-028 Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 75 179 000 \$ afin de financer des travaux de protection des immeubles municipaux

[By-law authorizing a loan of \$75,179,000 for work to protect municipal immovables]

- urban agglomeration council adopted the following by-law at its meeting of September 22, 2022:

RCG 22-031 Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 10 000 000 \$ afin de financer la réalisation de l'inventaire des immeubles construits avant 1940 sur le territoire de l'agglomération de Montréal et présentant une valeur patrimoniale

[By-law authorizing a loan of \$10,000,000 to take inventory of immovables built before 1940 on Montréal urban agglomeration territory that have heritage value]

The Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing approved by-laws RCG 22-027 and RCG 22-028 on September 29, 2022 and approved by-law RCG 22-031 on October 4, 2022. All these by-laws come into force on October 11, 2022 and may be consulted during regular office hours at the Service du greffe, 155 rue Notre-Dame Est.
