**DRAFT BY-LAW CONCERNING THE TAX CONCERNING SERVICES
(2023 FISCAL YEAR)**

NOTICE is hereby given that the draft by-law concerning the tax concerning services for the 2023 fiscal year, which was to have been presented at the regular meeting of the Côte-des-Neiges–Notre-Dame-de-Grâce Borough Council on October 6, has been postponed.

Consequently, the notice of motion of this draft by-law will be presented at the regular meeting of the Borough Council **at 7 p.m. on Monday, November 7, 2022**, to have the *By-law concerning the tax concerning services (2023 fiscal year)* adopted at a subsequent meeting.

THAT this draft by-law provides, as of the date it takes effect, that a special tax concerning services will be levied on the taxable value of any immovable entered on the property assessment roll and located in the borough, and that this rate may subsequently be adjusted.

THAT just as in 2022, the adoption of this by-law result in a transfer to the boroughs (special tax) of this portion of the fiscal space initially collected by the Ville de Montréal (general tax), so that boroughs can use this amount locally according to their needs and conditions.
