Notice is given that at the executive committee meeting of November 2, 2022, the following ordinance was adopted under article 136 of the By-law concerning fees (fiscal 2022) (22-004):

Ordonnance émise dans le cadre de la Campagne du coquelicot – Gratuité du stationnement tarifé sur rue (11)

This ordinance is issued as part of the Poppy Campaign to make paid on-street parking free, from November 3 to 11, 2022, for all vehicles with a licence plate featuring the red poppy image issued by an authority having jurisdiction.

The ordinance comes into force on November 3, 2022, and is available for consultation during regular office hours at the Service du greffe, 155, rue Notre-Dame Est, as well as online at montreal.ca/reglements-municipaux/.
