

ORDINANCES

Notice is given that the following ordinances were adopted at the executive committee meeting of November 2, 2022:

Ordonnance modifiant l'Ordonnance numéro 72 désignant le secteur « Hochelaga » aux fins de l'application du règlement (72-1)

Ordonnance émise afin de désigner le secteur « Gilford » aux fins de l'application du règlement (73)

Ordonnance émise afin de désigner le secteur « Jean-Talon / Viau » aux fins de l'application du règlement (74)

The ordinances mentioned above are adopted under article 22 of the By-law establishing the financial assistance program for establishments located in an area undergoing major work (RCG 18-043). Ordinance 72-1 amends the limits set out in Ordinance 72 of the "Hochelaga" designated work area. Under ordinances 73 and 74, by-law RCG 18-043 applies to the "Gilford" and "Jean-Talon / Viau" designated work areas as of November 9, 2022.

Ordonnance émise afin de bonifier le montant total de l'aide financière à l'article 3 du règlement (1)

This ordinance, adopted under article 43 of By-law concerning subsidies for the acquisition of immovables by social economy enterprises, and the construction and renovation of buildings designated for economic activities with a social purpose (RCG 21-019), increases the total value of the financial assistance set out in article 3 of the by-law to \$5,700,000.
