



## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

Section 9 - Act respecting the remuneration of elected municipal officers (CQLR, c. T-11.001)

Notice is given that the draft by-law titled “By-law amending the By-law concerning the remuneration of council members (02-039)” was presented at the city council meeting of December 19, 2022, and that a notice of motion was given for its adoption at a subsequent council meeting.

The draft by-law expands the scope of the provision under article 5.3 of by-law 02-039 to allow a council member to be absent without penalty due to an obligation related to the care of their child aged 14 years or younger or their child who has special needs.

This draft by-law will be listed for adoption by the city council at its regular meeting of Monday, January 23, 2023, at 1 p.m., in the council chamber of the Lucien-Saulnier building, located at 155, rue Notre-Dame Est (Champ-de-Mars metro station).

**RÈGLEMENT MODIFIANT LE RÈGLEMENT SUR LE TRAITEMENT DES  
MEMBRES DU CONSEIL (02-039)**

Vu l'article 2 de la Loi sur le traitement des élus municipaux (RLRQ, chapitre T-11.001);

À l'assemblée du XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX, le conseil municipal décrète :

**1.** L'article 5.3 du Règlement sur le traitement des membres du conseil (02-039) est modifié, au paragraphe 3°, par le remplacement des mots « moins de 18 semaines » par les mots « 14 ans et moins ou de son enfant ayant des besoins particuliers ».

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Ce règlement a été promulgué par l'avis public affiché à l'hôtel de ville (édifice Lucien-Saulnier) et publié dans *Le Devoir* le XXXX 2022.

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
