COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of February 23, 2023:

RCG 19-004-3 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le remorquage des véhicules (RCG 19-004)

[By-law amending the By-law concerning towing (RCG 19-004)]

The purpose of the amendments is to withdraw the provisions relating to temporary permits. Schedule B to the by-law is also replaced.

RCG 23-005 Règlement établissant le programme d'aide financière visant le développement de projets d'affaires d'entreprises montréalaises 2023

[By-law establishing the 2023 financial assistance program for business project development by Montréal enterprises]

The by-law takes effect conditionally to the signing of the financial assistance agreement between the city and the Minister of Economy, Innovation and Energy, which was approved by resolution CG23 0081.

These by-laws come into force March 1, 2023, and may be consulted during regular business hours at the Service du greffe, 155, rue Notre-Dame Est. They are also available at montreal.ca/reglements-municipaux/.
