

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that:

- city council adopted the following by-laws at its meeting of January 23, 2023:

23-003 Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 5 400 000 \$ pour financer le programme de soutien destiné aux arrondissements pour la mise aux normes d'équipements sportifs supra locaux

[By-law authorizing a loan of \$5,400,000 for the borough support program to bring supra-local sports facilities up to standard]

23-004 Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 32 100 000 \$ afin de financer les acquisitions immobilières ainsi que les travaux d'aménagement de la place publique Gérard-Godin et des rues aux abords

[By-law authorizing a loan of \$32,100,000 for immovable acquisitions as well as development work on the Gérard-Godin public square and the surrounding streets]

- city council adopted the following by-law at its meeting of February 20, 2023:

23-005 Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 17 349 000 \$ pour financer les travaux prévus au Programme de soutien à la mise aux normes des arénas municipaux

[By-law authorizing a loan of \$17,349,000 for work planned under the support program to bring municipal arenas up to standard]

The Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing approved by-laws 23-003 and 23-004 on March 22, 2023, and approved by-law 23-005 on March 23, 2023. All these by-laws come into force on March 31, 2022 and may be consulted during regular office hours at the Service du greffe, 155 rue Notre-Dame Est.
