

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given, in accordance with the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-law was adopted by city council at its meeting of February 20, 2023:

04-047-244 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)

The by-law amending the city's planning program increases the building density within the employment area bounded by Boulevard Henri-Bourassa, Boulevard Métropolitain and Boulevard Saint-Jean-Baptiste, in Rivière-des-Prairies–Pointe-aux-Trembles borough, and removes all reference to an area to be transformed for the territory concerned, now referred to as an established area. Following the public notice published on February 28, 2023, in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), this by-law is deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of March 31, 2023, and comes into force on that date.
