

ORDINANCES

Notice is given that the following ordinances were adopted at the executive committee meeting of April 5, 2023:

Ordonnance émise dans le cadre de la 24^e édition des Jeux FADOQ-Région Île de Montréal (6)

Ordonnance émise dans le cadre de l'accès gratuit au Jardin Botanique, au Biodôme, au Planétarium Rio Tinto Alcan ou à l'Insectarium pour les familles à faible revenu (7)

Ordinances 6 and 7 are adopted under article 123 of the By-law concerning fees (fiscal 2023) (22-054). Ordinance 6 allows FADOQ to use the multi-purpose room at the Claude-Robillard sports complex, free of charge, on May 26, 2023, during the 24th edition of the FADOQ games (island of Montréal region). Ordinance 7 provides free admission to low-income families who hold a pass issued by the city, valid for one visit per family, from May 1 to August 31, 2023 (Botanical Garden), from May 1 to December 23, 2023 (Biodôme and Rio Tinto Alcan Planetarium) as well as from September 5 to December 23, 2023 (Insectarium).

Ordonnance adoptée dans le cadre du Festival Eurêka! – Accès gratuit à la Biosphère et prêt de locaux (2)

Ordonnance émise dans le cadre de l'accès gratuit à la Biosphère pour les familles à faible revenu (3)

Ordinances 2 and 3 are adopted under article 92 of the By-law concerning fees of the urban agglomeration of Montréal (fiscal 2023) (RCG 22-037). Ordinance 2 provides for free admission to the Biosphère and the loan of spaces on May 26, 27 and 28, 2023, during the Eurêka! Festival. Ordinance 3 provides free admission to the Biosphère to low-income families who hold a pass issued by the city, valid for one visit per family, from May 1 to December 23, 2023.

All these ordinances come into force on April 12, 2023, and are available for consultation during regular office hours at the Service du greffe, 155, rue Notre-Dame Est, as well as online at montreal.ca/reglements-municipaux/.
