



COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of February 23, 2023:

RCG 23-004 Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 90 000 000 \$ afin de financer les travaux des aménagements cyclables

[By-law authorizing a loan of \$90,000,000 for bicycle path development work]

RCG 21-011-1 Règlement modifiant le Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 14 900 000 \$ afin de financer les travaux de rénovation de l'hôtel de ville de Montréal (RCG 21-011) afin d'augmenter le montant de l'emprunt à 24 900 000 \$

[By-law amending the By-law authorizing a loan of \$14,900,000 for renovation work at city hall (RCG 21-011) to increase the loan amount to \$24,900,000]
