COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that:

- urban agglomeration council adopted the following by-laws at its meeting of February 23, 2023:

RCG 23-002 Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 2 500 000 \$ afin de financer l'acquisition et l'installation d'équipements informatiques et électroniques ainsi que le remplacement d'instruments analytiques en matière environnementale

[By-law authorizing a loan of \$2,500,000 for the purchase and installation of computer and electronic equipment as well as the replacement of environmental analytical tools]

RCG 23-003 Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 19 500 000 \$ afin de financer la réalisation des travaux prévus au programme de protection du parc immobilier du Service de l'environnement

[By-law authorizing a loan of \$19,500,000 for work under the real estate holdings protection program of the Service de l'environnement]

- urban agglomeration council adopted the following by-law at its meeting of March 23, 2023:

RCG 23-006 Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 139 435 000 \$ afin de financer le remplacement et le reconditionnement de véhicules

[By-law authorizing a loan \$139,435,000 for the replacement and refurbishment of vehicles]

The Minister of Municipal Affairs approved by-law RCG 23-003 on April 26, 2023, and approved by-laws RCG 23-002 and RCG 23-006 on May 1, 2023. All these by-laws come into force on May 11, 2023 and may be consulted during regular office hours at the Service du greffe, 155 rue Notre-Dame Est.
