

**THE FUTURE OF THE MONTRÉAL'S WATER
PUBLIC CONSULTATION**

The [Commission sur l'eau, l'environnement, le développement durable et les grands parcs](#) (committee) holds a public consultation to guide the next Montréal water strategy.

The committee invites interested parties to participate in the public consultation that will be held in three steps. The first step is to inform the population of the greater Montréal area on major water issues and its management, especially in the context of adaptation to climate change. The second step is to gather diverse views on water priorities and management. Finally, the third step of the consultative process will result in the public adoption of the recommendations that the committee intends to submit to the administration at the end of its examination.
