COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of August 21, 2023:

- 03-009-15 Règlement modifiant le Règlement intérieur du conseil sur la délégation de pouvoirs au comité exécutif (03-009)**
The by-law amends the by-law concerning the delegation of city council powers to the executive committee (03-009) by delegating the authority to act on behalf of the city for the purpose of any management agreement entered into with the Société d'habitation et de développement de Montréal for the management of buildings acquired for residential purposes, particularly following the exercise of the city's pre-emptive right.
- 23-023 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur la subvention à la modification du raccordement du service électrique de certains bâtiments (R.R.V.M., chapitre S-6.01)**
The by-law amends the by-law concerning subsidies for the alteration of the electrical service connection of certain buildings (R.B.C.M., c. S-6.01) by adding the sectors of Boulevard Gouin Ouest (Ahuntsic-Cartierville) as well as Rue Saint-Urbain and Rue Saint-Zotique Ouest (Rosemont-La Petite-Patrie) and specifying the maximum amount of the subsidy applicable to the addresses of these sectors. Schedule M is also amended by adding of an address and increasing a subsidy amount.
- 23-024 Règlement sur la fermeture d'une rue située au nord de la 14^e Avenue, entre la rue René-Lévesque et la rue De La Gauchetière, dans l'arrondissement de Rivière-des-Prairies–Pointe-aux-Trembles, aux fins de transfert aux propriétaires riverains**
The by-law closes a lane located north of 14^e Avenue, between Rue René-Lévesque and Rue De La Gauchetière, in Rivière-des-Prairies–Pointe-aux-Trembles borough, for the purposes of transfer to bordering owners.
