COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given, in accordance with the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-law was adopted by city council at its meeting of August 21, 2023:

04-047-254 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)

The by-law amends the city's planning program (by-law 04-047), specifically map 2.5.1 (parks and green spaces) with respect to Ville-Marie borough, by adding to the "park" land use designation certain lots within Parc des Faubourgs and removing from such land use designation other lots located near the Jacques-Cartier bridge. (CM23 0964)

Following the public notice published on August 30, 2023, in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), this by-law is deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of September 30, 2023, and comes into force on that date.
