



ORDINANCES

Notice is given that the following ordinances were adopted at the executive committee meeting of November 1, 2023:

Ordonnance abrogeant l'ordonnance numéro 10 désignant le secteur « Ottawa – Murray » aux fins de l'application du règlement (10-1)

Ordonnance modifiant l'ordonnance numéro 17 désignant le secteur « Sainte-Catherine Ouest – Phase 2 » aux fins de l'application du règlement (17-1)

These two ordinances, are adopted under article 16 of by-law RCG 23-013 establishing the lump-sum subsidy program for establishments located in an area undergoing major work. Ordinance 10-1 repeals ordinance 10 designating the “Ottawa – Murray” sector for the purposes of applying the by-law. Ordinance 17-1 amends ordinance 17 designating the “Sainte-Catherine Ouest – Phase 2” sector for the purposes of applying the by-law, by setting a new start date for work in that sector.

Ordonnance modifiant l'ordonnance numéro 81 désignant le secteur « Sainte-Catherine Ouest – Phase 2 » aux fins de l'application du règlement (81-1)

This ordinance, adopted under article 22 of by-law RCG 18-043 establishing the financial assistance program for establishments located in an area undergoing major work, amends ordinance 81 designating the “Sainte-Catherine Ouest – Phase 2” sector for the purposes of applying the by-law, by setting a new start date for work in that sector.
