

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given, in accordance with the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-law was adopted by city council at its meeting of October 16, 2023:

04-047-255 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)

The by-law amends the city's planning program (by-law 04-047) and concerns the removal of 14 places of worship from the list of buildings of heritage and architectural interest outside areas of exceptional value, in Ville-Marie borough, as well as the creation of the category "Buildings with a cultural-historical vocation". (CM23 1173)

Following the public notice published on October 25, 2023, in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), this by-law is deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of November 25, 2023, and comes into force on that date.
