

## COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

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Notice is given, in accordance with the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-law was adopted by city council at its meeting of November 20, 2023:

**04-047-257    Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)**

The by-law amends the city's planning program (by-law 04-047) and concerns the site made up of lots 4 594 306 and 4 594 307, cadastre of Québec, located at 6900-7000, Boulevard Louis-H.-La Fontaine, in Anjou borough. It amends the land use designation to expand the "residential sector" land use designation area within the "employment sector". (CM23 1307)

Following the public notice published on November 28, 2023, in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), this by-law is deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of December 29, 2023, and comes into force on that date.
