



COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of January 25, 2024:

- RCG 24-001 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur la subvention à la réalisation de logements coopératifs et à but non lucratif (AccèsLogis Montréal) (02-102)**
This by-law amends article 7.5 of by-law 02-102 concerning subsidies for the development of non-profit cooperative housing (AccèsLogis Montréal) and concerns the parameters for determining the amount of the start-up subsidy.
- RCG 19-003-4 Règlement modifiant le Règlement intérieur du conseil d'agglomération sur la délégation de pouvoirs du conseil d'agglomération au comité exécutif relatif à l'exercice du droit de préemption aux fins de parc régional (RCG 19-003)**
This by-law amends urban agglomeration council internal management by-law RCG 19-003 concerning the delegation of urban agglomeration council powers to the executive committee regarding the exercise of the pre-emptive right for regional park purposes to take into account 32 additional lots (Grand parc de l'Est) subject to right of first refusal under resolution CG23 0750.
- RCG 24-006 Règlement établissant le programme d'aide financière visant le développement de projets d'affaires d'entreprises montréalaises 2024-2025**
This by-law establishes the financial assistance program concerning the development of business projects of Montréal enterprises 2024-2025
- RCG 24-007 Règlement modifiant le Règlement établissant le programme d'aide financière visant le développement de projets d'affaires d'entreprises montréalaises (RCG 19-017) et modifiant le Règlement établissant le programme d'aide financière visant le développement de projets d'affaires d'entreprises montréalaises 2023 (RCG 23-005)**
This by-law amends by-law RCG 19-017 establishing the financial assistance program for the development of business projects of Montréal enterprises and by-law RCG 23-005 establishing the 2023 financial assistance program for business project development by Montréal enterprises. The amendments allow the use of amounts remaining or recovered under by-laws RCG 19-017 and RCG 23-005 and to pay them out in accordance with the criteria set out in by-law RCG 24-006. Amendments are also made to harmonize reporting requirements.

All these by-laws come into force January 31, 2024, and may be consulted (French version only) during regular business hours at the Service du greffe, 155, rue Notre-Dame Est. They are also available at montreal.ca/reglements-municipaux/.
