NOTICE OF PUBLIC CONSULTATION

NOTICE is given to all persons concerned by draft by-law entitled:

BY-LAW AMENDING THE BY-LAW CONCERNING MUNICIPAL WORKS AGREEMENTS FOR DEVELOPMENT AND UNDER THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE URBAN AGGLOMERATION COUNCIL (02-193)

The draft by-law entitled *By-law amending the by-law concerning municipal works* agreements for the development of residential projects (02-193) was adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of August 31, 2006.

In accordance with section 125 of the *Land Use Planning and Development Act* .(R.S.Q., chapter A-19.1), a public consultation will be held on Tuesday, September 12, 2006 at 7 p.m., in the council chamber of city hall, 275 Notre-Dame Street East, in Montréal, presided by a member of council designated by the Mayor of Montréal.

At the meeting, the member of council designated by the mayor will explain the draft bylaw and hear persons and organizations wishing to express their views. These persons and organizations should register between 6:30 p.m. and 7 p.m.

OBJECT OF DRAFT BY-LAW

The object of the draft by-law, which will apply to the entire territory of the agglomeration of Montréal, is to amend by-law 02-193 concerning agreements on municipal works under agglomeration jurisdiction, required for the development of residential projects. Specifically, it aims to extend the by-law to cover commercial projects and facilitate the application of the by-law.

The draft by-law introduces the concept of cost sharing in the case where infrastructure works on a site benefit both the developer applying for a permit and other persons whose land is adjacent to the infrastructure in question.

The draft by-law also clarifies the existing definitions of prerequisites, infrastructure works on site and oversizing.

The draft by-law contains no provisions making it a by-law subject to approval by way of referendum.

The draft by-law and a related document can be consulted at any Accès Montréal office, borough office, city halls and at the Direction du greffe, 275 Notre-Dame Street East, Suite R-134, during regular office hours.
